Applications in the prescribed form are invited from eligible candidates for the entrance test and admission into 5 year Integrated PG Courses in PHYSICS & CHEMISTRY (English Medium) at SVU Campus, Tirupati and BIO-TECHNOLOGY at Vikrama Simhapuri University, Nellore for the year 2009-10. The University reserves the right to change or modify any of the rules and regulations including the scheme of examination and the syllabi of the course. The decision of the admission committee is final in all matters related to these admissions.

The Directorate of Admissions, SV University, Tirupati will conduct the entrance test and make admissions into 5 year Integrated PG courses for the year 2009-10.

GENERAL

Admissions are limited to only those candidates who are local to one or the other University areas of A.P. State.

Indian Nationals who are natives of other states (other than AP) are also eligible for admission under National Integration Quota (5%) subject to satisfying the eligibility criteria and Rank in the entrance test.

Foreign nationals/NRIs can be admitted without entrance test subject to satisfying the eligibility criteria and production of STUDENT VISA for the period of study in the University.

No candidate is entitled to pursue more than one full time course at a time. If admitted, no candidate can undertake any other assignment or employment, or study any other course simultaneously with the exception of evening part time courses offered by the University.

If it is proved that any of the certificates submitted by a candidate was tampered or fake, the candidate not only loses seat but also is liable for prosecution.

HOW TO APPLY

Application Form and Instruction Booklet can be downloaded from the website www.svudoa.com.

The duly filled-in application forms along with a DD for Rs. 250/- towards registration fee, drawn on any nationalized bank in favour of “Director, Directorate of Admissions”, payable at TIRUPATI with name and address of the candidate written on the reverse of the draft should be submitted either in person or sent by registered post so as to reach on or before **08-06-2009** to the following address:

Incomplete applications will be rejected. Applications received after the specified date will be summarily rejected and the cost of application will not be refunded. The Director is not responsible for any postal delay or loss in postal transit.

ELIGIBILITY FOR WRITING THE ENTRANCE TEST

The candidate should have passed the +2 examination (Intermediate or equivalent as recognized by Board of Intermediate Education, AP) with a minimum of 50% in group subjects Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry (OR) Biology, Physics, Chemistry. Pass is sufficient for SC/ST candidates.

The candidates who have appeared for the final year qualifying examination are also eligible to take the test. But they should have passed the qualifying examination with requisite minimum marks by the time the admissions are made.

Candidates who qualify themselves in the entrance test, but do not have the requisite percentage of marks in the qualifying examination or not satisfying the subject eligibility requirement are not eligible for admission.

Candidates who pass the qualifying examination in September / October supplementary examinations of 2009 will not be eligible for admission during the academic year 2009-2010.

SEATS AND COURSE FEE

The intake of students for each course is 30. The duration of the course is 5 years (10 semesters).

The Tuition and Special fee per semester: Rs. 4325/- (Rs. 1550/- for BC/SC/ST*). (Subject to change).

(* Only for those SC/ST/BC candidates whose parent’s income is less than Rs.1,00,000/- per annum (In case the tuition fee and special fee for these candidates is not reimbursed by the Government, the students will have to pay the necessary fees at the respective colleges).

All candidates admitted have to pay Rs. 125/- extra towards Recognition fee.

Candidates admitted have to pay Rs. 50/- (Rs. 25/- for SC/ST) extra towards counseling fee.

The other fee, if any, shall be intimated at the time of admissions.

ENTRANCE TEST

The entrance test shall be for 3 hours duration with 150 Multiple choice questions. The Syllabus for the entrance test is same as the Intermediate course. The entrance test question paper consists of three sections as detailed below:

Section A : Physics - 50 questions

Section B : Chemistry - 50 questions

Section C : Mathematics or Biology - 50 questions

Date of Entrance Test : 11-06-2009 at 9.00 a.m.**

No candidate will be permitted into the examination hall without proper hall ticket.

No candidate will be allowed to carry calculators, books, papers, mathematical and physical tables, slide rules, pagers, electronic organizers, digital diaries, cellular phones or any other calculating aid into the examination hall.

HALL TICKETS

Hall Tickets for the entrance test should be collected at the office of the Directorate of Admissions, SV University, Tirupati on the day of examination. The candidates are advised to preserve the Hall ticket till the admission is completed.

QUALIFYING MARK

The minimum marks for qualifying at the entrance test is 25. However, for the SC/ST candidates there is no qualifying mark.

RANKING

When there is a tie on the basis of marks obtained in the test as a whole, it will be resolved on the basis of marks obtained in Section A. If there is still a tie, it will be resolved on the basis of marks obtained in Section B. If there is still a tie, they will be ranked as per seniority in age.

Rank cards will be posted to the candidates within ten days after the publication of results.

Any candidate, who has lost or not received the rank card, can apply to the Directorate along with a demand draft for Rs. 25/- drawn in favour of Director, Directorate of Admissions, S.V. University for a duplicate rank card.

The rank obtained in the test is valid for admission only for the academic year 2009-2010.

There is no provision for **REVALUATION** or **PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION OF ANSWER SHEETS**.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission into Physics, Chemistry at SVU Campus, Tirupati and Biotechnology at Vikram Simhapuri University, Nellore is based on the rank secured in the entrance test conducted by S.V. University. In Biotechnology 15 seats have been allotted for M.P.C and 15 for Bi.P.C. candidates.

The candidate should have passed the qualifying examination with minimum percentage of marks as mentioned above, when he/she is called for the interview for admission, failing which the qualified candidates next in rank would be admitted.

Admission into the course will be done by calling three candidates for every seat in each category. Candidates have to attend the interview at the appointed venue, date and time at their own expenses with the required documents and fees.

If a candidate fails to attend the interview at the specified date and time for whatever reason (including non – receipt or delayed receipt of call letter), he/she will forfeit the seat and the candidate next in rank will be considered for admission. Any representation for postponement of the date and time of personal appearance will not be entertained.

If a candidate reports himself/herself after the interview is over with some valid reason, such a candidate on written representation may be considered for admission into the course if only there is a vacancy in the particular category for which he/she is eligible.

At the time of interview, the following original documents should be submitted by the candidate:

- a) Rank card and Hall Ticket
- b) Transfer and Conduct certificates (Admission will not be given if T.C. of the institution where the candidate studied last is not submitted)
- c) SSC
- d) Intermediate pass-cum-marks certificates
- e) Six Passport size photographs
- f) Study certificates from VI class to qualifying examination

- g) Caste certificate in original from the Tahshildar. in case of SC/ST/BC candidates, obtained in 2009 OR permanent caste certificate
- h) Two income certificates from the Tahshildar obtained in 2009 (for those who wish to apply for scholarship/fee concession).
- i) Relevant certificate in case of physically handicapped/extra curricular activities (NCC/NSS/Games & Sports / Cultural Activity) category
- j) Discharge certificate and service certificate of the parent in case of a child of armed person.
- k) Residence Certificate of parents for stay in the state of A.P. from M.R.O. in case of Candidates, who have studied outside A.P./ carried out private study.
- l) Migration certificate (for other University candidates)

Admission list will be finalized on the day of interview on the basis of rank obtained in the entrance test and fulfillment of eligibility criteria subject to rules of reservation. A candidate who cannot produce all the necessary certificates at the time of counseling will forfeit admission and the candidate next in rank would be admitted.

If selected, the candidate has to pay the prescribed fees immediately. The admission is purely provisional.

The cases of pending revaluation will not be considered.

HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION

Limited accommodation is available in the SV University Hostels. Admission to hostels will be made as per the rules in vogue.
