II. HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION

1. Admission does not automatically entitle accommodation in the University Hostels. Only limited accommodation is available in the University Hostels for Men and Women. Admission to hostels will be made as per rules in vogue.
2. Accommodation cannot be provided in the University Hostels to any student who is a native of any area with in 20 kms radius of Tirupati
3. Hostel accommodation will not be provided to those who wish to pursue another PG course.

III. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. A candidate who has not passed the qualifying degree examination with the minimum marks prescribed in section 3 of the Instruction Booklet is not eligible for admission.
2. At the time of counselling, the candidate has to submit the following certificates **in Original:**
 - a. SVUCET-2009 Rank Card and Hall-Ticket (A candidate who lost Rank card/Hall Ticket can download the same from the web site and attend counseling).
 - b. Provisional / Degree certificate of the qualifying examination
 - c. Marks statements of all the years of qualifying examination

- d. Transfer and Conduct certificate (**Admission will not be done without submission of Original Transfer Certificate (TC)**).
- e. Secondary School Certificate (SSC)
- f. Study certificates from IX class to qualifying examination.
- g. Caste certificate in original from the Tahsildar obtained in 2009 or permanent caste certificate (in the case of SC/ST/BC candidates).
- h. **Two income certificates** from the Tahsildar obtained in 2009 (for those who wish to apply for scholarship/fee concession).
- i. Relevant certificates in the case of Physically Handicapped / Extra Curricular Activities (NCC /NSS /Games/ Sports/ Cultural Activities).
- j. Residence certificate of parent for stay in the state of AP from the Tahsildar in the case of candidates who have studied outside AP or carried out private study.
- k. Discharge certificate and Service certificate of the parent in the case of a child of armed personnel.
- l. Migration certificate (for other University candidates)

3. **No admission will be given if the candidate fails to submit the relevant certificates mentioned in item-1 above.**
4. **The selected candidate has to submit all the original certificates along with two sets of Xerox copies and no extension of time will be given for submission of certificates.**
5. **The selected candidate has to pay the fee on the spot and no extension of time will be given for payment of fee.**
6. A candidate who fails to attend the counselling on the specified date and time will forfeit the right for admission.
7. A candidate who is now doing a PG course in any other Institution will be considered for admission only on the production of a certificate from the concerned Principal / Head of the Institution / College to the effect that the candidate is a student of the Institution and the certificates including TC will be released to the candidate if he/she is selected for admission. **Notional admission** will be given to such candidates by allowing **4 days** time. If the candidate fails to submit the original certificates before the stipulated date, his/her notional admission will be cancelled.
8. If it is found that the admission is secured on false grounds or by suppression of facts, his/her admission will be cancelled.
9. **The candidate has to come prepared to stay for one more day, if necessary.**

Where both Regular and Self-Supporting courses for the same course are run in a particular college, then sanction of scholarship may be restricted to the fee rate sanctioned for the Regular course. In such cases the SC /ST candidates have to pay almost the total fee for Self-supporting courses vide G.O. MS.No.56, Social Welfare Department, dated 06-10-2003.

Note: Other University students have to pay an additional fee of Rs. 125/- . Each admitted candidate has to pay an additional amount of Rs.50/- (Rs.25/- for SC/ST) towards counseling fee.

3. PAID SEATS

In all Regular Courses where there are no sponsored seats, additional seats are provided in each course as paid seats as per the details given below. The candidates selected for admission under this category have to pay an additional one-time fee of Rs. 20,000/- for Arts courses, Rs. 30,000/- for M.Com and M.L.I.Sc. and Rs. 50,000/- for Science courses in addition to the Tuition fee and Special fee of the respective courses.
